### **CONTEST RULES**

## **Eligibility**

No purchase necessary. This contest is organized by the University of Ottawa and is open to all University of Ottawa students aged 17 and older and resident of Ontario. You are not eligible to enter if you are (or you live or are domiciled with) an employee, director, representative or agent of the University of Ottawa.

#### To Enter

To enter, the entrant must complete the contest entry form and answer a skill-testing question. The contest begins on September 3<sup>rd</sup> at 4 p.m. EST and ends on October 17th at 12 p.m. EST. One (1) entry per entrant for the entire contest period. By entering you agree that you have read and understood these Contest Rules.

#### Prize

Four (4) prizes consisting of vouchers for 52 free medium three toppings pizza valued each at \$1039.48 (pizza value of \$19.99) or a total value of \$4157.92 (Canadian dollars). Four (4) prizes consisting of vouchers for four (4) free medium three toppings pizza valued each at \$79.96 (pizza value of \$19.99) or a total value of \$319.84 (Canadian dollars). Four (4) prizes consisting of a voucher for one (1) free medium three toppings pizza valued each at \$19.99 or a total value of \$79.96 (Canadian dollars). The prize must be accepted as awarded or forfeited and cannot be redeemed for cash or credit.

# Selection of Contestants

One contestant per regular season home game will be randomly selected amongst all respondents on the Thursday prior to every home game.

The contestant will be informed by email following the draw. To win, the selected entrant must have correctly answered the skill testing question, completed all fields requesting information and must successfully kick a field goal from the 20, 30 and/or 40 yard lines at the upcoming home game.
