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Qualifications for Honoured Membership

ATHLETE:

1. Must have played at least three (3) years with the Gee-Gees in which basic athletic skills which led to their distinction as an athlete were demonstrated.
2. Not normally considered until five (5) years following retirement from the Gee-Gees football program.

BUILDER:

1. A builder shall be a person who has contributed to the sports heritage of Gee-Gees football for a period of not less than five (5) years. Although such a period of service not necessarily be consecutive.
2. Must have made a major contribution to the development and advancement of the Gee-Gees football program.
3. Examples of builders may include: coach, support staff, medical staff, donor and volunteer.

TEAM:

1. Must have won a championship.
2. A team will be eligible for induction after a minimum of 20 years from the championship win.
3. Members of a team eligible for election into the University of Ottawa Gee-Gees Football Hall of Fame shall be only those whose names appear on the official team roster for which the championship is being claimed.
